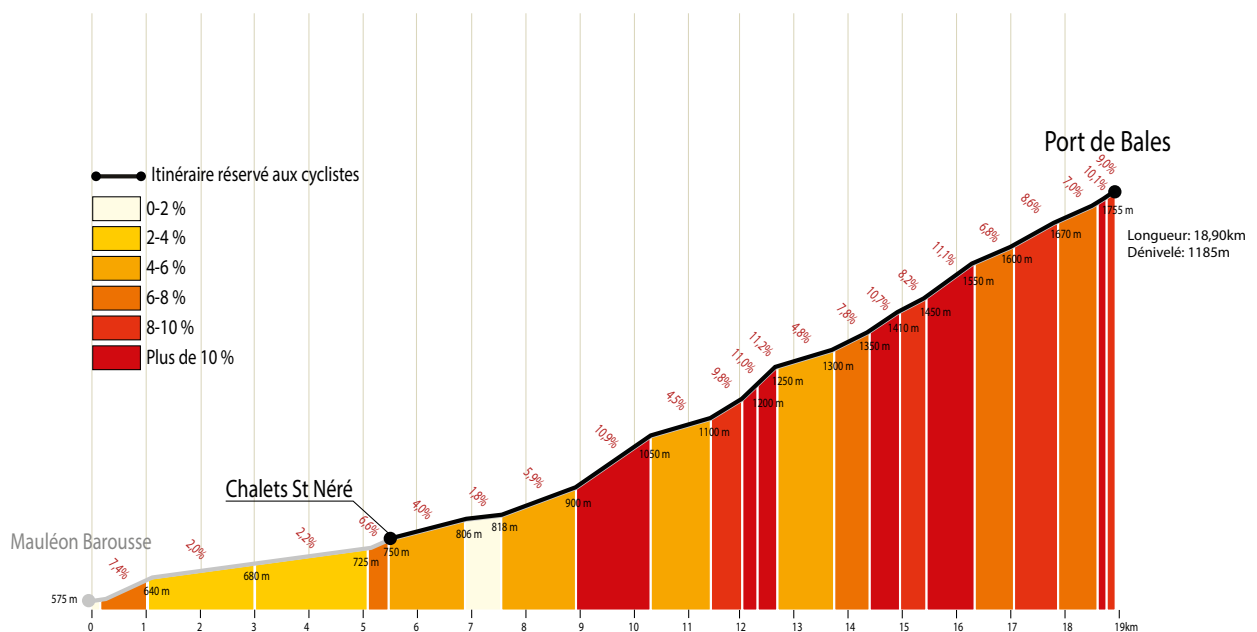


MONDAY 25th JULY 2022

✘ PORT DE BALÈS - EAST SIDE

The Port de Balès is between Barousse and Oueil Valley and was only opened to vehicles in 2006, even though the Tour de France has passed through here 6 times already! It was climbed for the last time on the 8th stage of the 2020 Tour edition "Cazères-sur-Garonne – Loudenvielle". From the village of Ferrères, the road takes you through the majestic Barousse Forest, before winding round the mountain pastures for the last few kilometers up to the summit, where the views are quite simply breath-taking.

% average: 6.3%

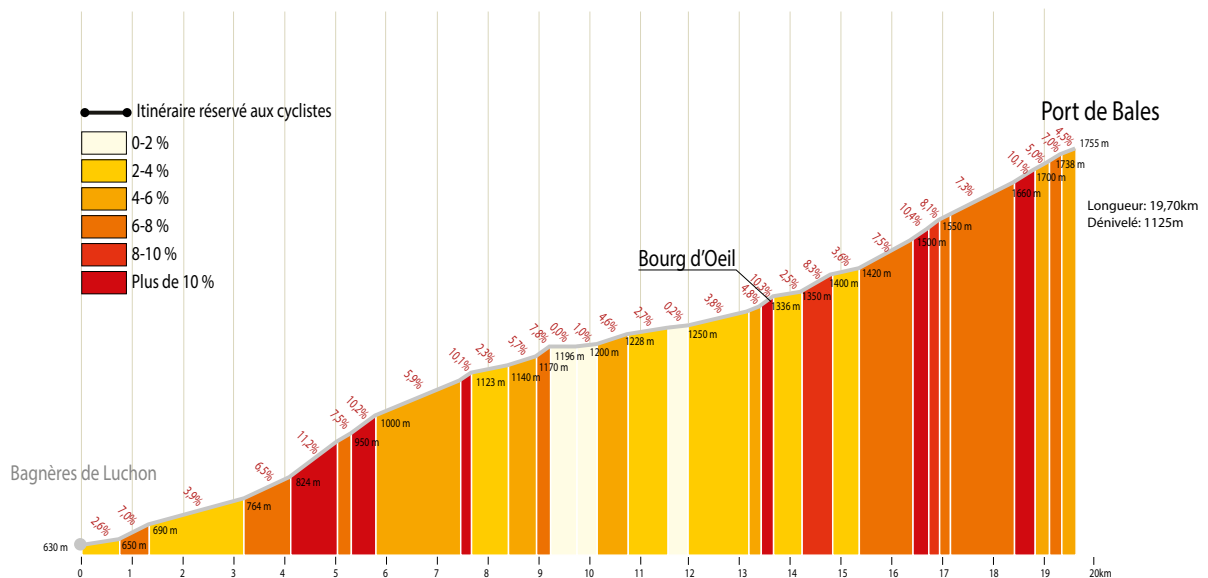
